

Want to know what Little John's House actually looks like? Here is a quick photo tour of LJH...

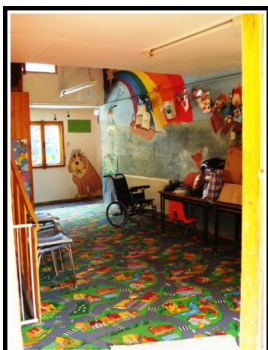
From the drive of Little John's House looking at the main house. This is where the children eat, play and sleep:



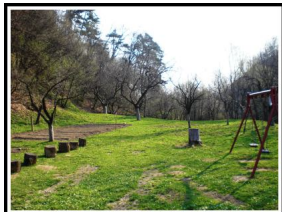
The barn. Converted to house two play rooms, accomodation for volunteers during summer school and a small flat for longer term volunteers (where Beth is staying at the moment):
